

## Education

In Education, we focus on supporting access to education at primary, secondary and tertiary levels through:

### Learning Materials

Provision of learning materials/aids and library materials

### Provision of Bursaries

Provision of bursaries and scholarships to needy students from poor backgrounds

### Provision of ICT learning equipment

Improve the learning outcomes through the provision of strategic ICT learning equipment such as laptops and desktop computers to selected schools

# Youth Empowerment

The foundation aims at building the youth for the future through skills development, training and support for business startups. In this program, we have three broad areas of intervention.



## Skills Upgrade.

This area focuses on capacity building to prepare the youth for the modern skills demands through Information Communication Technology (ICT) development, career guidance, online work and self-employment opportunities and mentorship. We link youths to appropriate career training opportunities and support them access these opportunities.



## Talent Development.

The focus here is on identifying young talents, guidance and linkages to appropriate career pathways. As part of talent development, we provide young people with sporting activities and events. This serves two main purposes, first is to keep the youth busy and away from anti-social and risky behaviour (early pregnancies, drugs and alcohol abuse) through life-skills training and secondly, early identification of sports talents among the youth.



# Health Education

Access to affordable quality healthcare remains a challenge in the areas we work. In addition, health-seeking behaviour is largely affected by the high levels of poverty, inadequate information and low levels of education. The Foundation works with the communities to raise awareness of specific areas that have a direct impact on preventable health problems. These include:



## Maternal Health

Maternal Health and Nutrition Awareness creation.



## Mental Health counselling

Mental Health counselling, psychosocial support and re-integration through partnerships



## Health Awareness

Awareness on health-seeking behaviour, nutrition through referrals, partnerships with MoH



## Free medical camp

The Foundation regularly holds free medical camps as well as financial support to the needy with life-threatening medical conditions, and linkages to experts and specialists.

Training and supporting households on the construction of hygienic affordable ablution facilities such as improved pit latrines and bio-latrines




## Biogas Convert and construct
